Service & Description	Fee
Retrospective & Concurrent File Review Forensic review involving past/ongoing/current care, with a determination of the medical necessity of care rendered to date, appropriate coding and the determination of any future care being requested/recommended. Files larger than 250 pages would be \$800/review.	\$700/review
Rush Review Reviews where an opinion report is required within 24 hours of submitting the file for review (next business day). May be concurrent or retrospective.	\$200 in addition to review fee
Teleconference with Providers Includes discussions with the provider, if requested by the carrier, patient or treating provider, regarding the decision on a prior medical necessity review with a detailed written report following the discussion with the provider for the client's files.	\$200/call
Research/Guideline Services Includes web-based research of new techniques/services, their validity and determination of effectiveness, research on how other third party payers address the issue/service, guideline conception, generation and review and any time based appeal committee work or procedural meetings.	\$300/hour
Provider Network Services Includes generation of necessary forms, screening of applicants (on site interviews may have additional travel/lodging charges) and ongoing management of the provider network.	\$300/hour
Telephone Conference with Attorneys not to exceed 30 minutes not to exceed 45 minutes not to exceed 60 minutes	\$200 \$300 \$400
Internal Educational discussions Includes hand-out booklet and a 90 minute PowerPoint presentation of an overview of the chiropractic profession, its philosophy, techniques, documentation guidelines, treatment/coding "red flags" processing tips, company-provider relationships, current professional trends, question and answer sessions.	\$1100
